How we use collected information

We may collect visitors' personal identification information to enhance our publicity and to run events and activities. Users can unsubscribe to receiving newsletters etc. at any point via the unsubscribe link or by contacting us via the website.

We may collect non- personal identification information to improve our customer service and improve the engagement of visitors with our webpages.

How we store your data

We ensure we have appropriate data collection, storage and processing practices and security measures to protect against access, alteration, disclosure or destruction of your personal information.

How we share your personal information

We do not sell or trade User's personal identification information to other organisations. We may use third party service providers to enable us to circulate our newsletters or publicity. We will only share your data with these organisations for the purposes you have given us in your permission.

Your rights

Users can unsubscribe to receiving newsletters etc. at any point via the unsubscribe link or by contacting us via the website.

If we wish to use your personal information for a new purpose, not covered by this existing notice, we will publish an updated notice on our website setting out the changes.
